

Safe walking routes



T4 Baggage Area

Go to Reclaim Belt 2 following the safe walking route internal to the Main Baggage Hall. Follow the signs to the event using the dedicated footpath.

Terminal Building

The closest point to access to the event from the terminal area is gate 404. From this point a safe walking route to the event will be signposted. A safe walking route is also available from Reclaim Belt 2 inside Baggage Reclaim Area.



The crossing from the equipment area by stand 404 to stand 461 will be monitored by a Road Traffic Marshal

The Assembly Point for Stand 524 is on Terminal Approach Rd South, sideways to stand 524 or by the bus stop area, on the left side of the SAA



Safe walking routes



From Terminal Building

Go to the Pax Baggage Reclaim Hall, walk to Reclaim Belt 11 and access to the ramp areas from the last door on the right of the Hall. Turn right, walk through two doors until you are outside. Walk to stand 523 and proceed to stand 524 following the safe walking route.

From Control Post 19-20

Follow signs to VIP suite and stop by stand 524, opposite BA Operations Building (SAA). There are safe walking routes directly outside the CHSS and BA OPS buildings.

Safe walking routes



T1 Baggage Area

Exit the T1 Baggage Area and follow the safe walking route on the pavement opposite Stand 209. Continue walking along this route until you reach the pavement in front of Stand 213. Then, turn right and follow the walking route underneath the baggage area until you reach the T2 main baggage area, where a crossing will provide access to the KAD site.


Go to Gates A1-A5, exit the building on T2 Road East and follow the signs to the event.

In The Event of Fire

Safe walking routes (from Cambridge Building)



Cambridge Building

Follow the safe walking route to Terminal 2 Building. Walk along the building on the pavement, then turn left when you reach the roundabout near stand 221. Continue walking until you reach the Drop Off-Pick Up areas. From there, follow the signs to the event.

Terminal Building

Go to Gates A1-A5, exit the terminal building on T2 Road East (at the head of stand 217) and follow the signs to the event.

T1 Baggage Area

Use safe walking routes within the baggage facility to reach the Baggage Display. Ensure your ID pass displays 3 and B to visit the Baggage Display. To visit the KAD site, please use the safe walking route as displayed on the map.

Cambridge Building

Follow the safe walking route to Terminal 2 Building. Walk along the building on the pavement, then turn left when you reach the roundabout near stand 221. Continue walking until you reach the Coaches Drop Off-Pick Up area. From there, follow the signs to the event.

Terminal Building

Go to Gates A1-A5, exit the terminal building on T2 Road East and follow the signs to the event.



T3 Baggage Area

Exit T3IB MBH Rd North from the entrance/exit door nearby Reclaim Belt 1 and follow the signs to stand 351. T3IB MBH Parking area is the area opposite as you walk outside

Terminal Building

Reach the Drop off area (bus stops 24A&B), follow the signs to CP8 until you find the signs to stand 351 / T3IB MBH Parking area.

Control Point 8 Follow footpath to Building 1082 (Campus Security), proceed towards T3 Baggage Facility, follow the signs to Stand 351/ T3IB MBH Parking area.



The crossing from the equipment area by stand 405 to stand 461 will be monitored by a Road Traffic Marshal
