Operational Planning allows us to meet our ambition despite the changes we continuously experience as one of the busiest airports in the world. The team are responsible for creating the right planning proposition, from defining roles to building rosters, and delivering an effective plan every day. It is about understanding our capacity and making best use of it as well as evaluating our performance every day, so we can continuously improve.

Operational Capacity and Planning

We are the custodians of Heathrow's Capacity and encompass an array of Operational areas. This includes Check-In, Baggage, Security, Immigration, Stands and more - we are continuing to expand out remit and planning influence on other parts of the airport, establishing the links and interdependencies between each area to establish a single consolidated operational plan.

We are responsible for providing the operation with the right plan to deliver Heathrow's vision. We plan the end-to-end passenger journey and set our operational teams up for success by communicating and delivering intricate, detailed, and comprehensive plans.

The **Planning and Intelligence Manager** role (or PIM for short) is the part that ties it all together. Each PIM is a subject matter expert in for their operational area, it's an exciting fast paced role where you are empowered to make decisions and challenge the status quo. It's not always easy and that's why it's a great place to be if you want to continue to stretch yourself and learn every day.


Some of the key accountabilities of the PIM role are.


- Owning your Operational Plan You control the plan that the operation receives. Working closely with our forecasting team you will take the forecast and turn it into a fully-fledged operational plan. You'll need to understand your area's capability, resilience, nuances, challenges and continually monitor and adapt your planning principals as the environment shifts.
- Building far reaching relationships Forecasting, Ops Delivery teams, Ops Leadership teams, 3rd Party suppliers, Airline Stakeholders and sometimes even Heathrow's executive committee, the PIM role has a high level of exposure across Heathrow. Having interactions with such a wide range of stakeholders provides a unique development opportunity where you will need to become adept in communicating at different levels and agile in how you manage conversations. In some situations, a strong negotiating style is needed and other a more direct and stronger stance may be the right approach depending on the goal you are looking to achieve.
- Plan, Do, Review A good PIM is inquisitive by nature and is always striving to improve the plan. It is a data heavy role, so you need to be comfortable with numbers and can derive insight 'beyond the data'. Data is great but it is only one part of the puzzle, when combined with a strategic mind this is when the magic happens!

What We Do

The Performance and Analytics team sits within Operational Planning and are responsible for helping identify and reporting on key operational metrics, analysing performance, providing actionable insights to the business, and developing modelling tools to help improve operational plans and increase the scope of the plans. The purpose of the team is to combine an understanding of airport operations with modern data analysis, visualisation and storytelling, enabling Heathrow's transformation into a proactive, 'Smart Airport', growing our passenger volumes whilst protecting operational resilience and continuing to deliver an excellent passenger experience.

The role of an Ops Planning Analyst involves working dynamically with all areas of the operation, including Security, Services, Airport Operations and Engineering, helping the business adopt a more data-driven culture and building on its data science capabilities. The role will work with both historic data and future forecasts, looking to combine datasets to provide a clearer and enriched view of the operation on which to generate the plans. The role will work with and influence a wide range of operational teams, providing trusted support and driving continuous improvement initiatives.
