

# HEATHROW HOSTED A THIRD “METHODS & METRICS” WORKSHOP ON WEDNESDAY 30<sup>TH</sup> APRIL

The workshop was intended for “*a technically-engaged audience with a good understanding of the background to this project*”.

The purpose of the workshop was to:

- Provide an update on work undertaken since passing the Stage 2 Gateway in July 2024
- Share Heathrow’s approach to the compilation of System Options at Stage 3 and take feedback on it

## Summary of feedback:

- Stakeholders appreciated the information and the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback
- Stakeholders generally supported our approach to compiling system options and welcomed the inclusion of a Minimal Change option
- Stakeholders had questions relating to the introduction of UKADS and Heathrow’s expansion proposals, but they accepted that these could not be answered at this time
- Stakeholders value opportunities to engage with Heathrow, especially on the metrics we use to present and assess options
