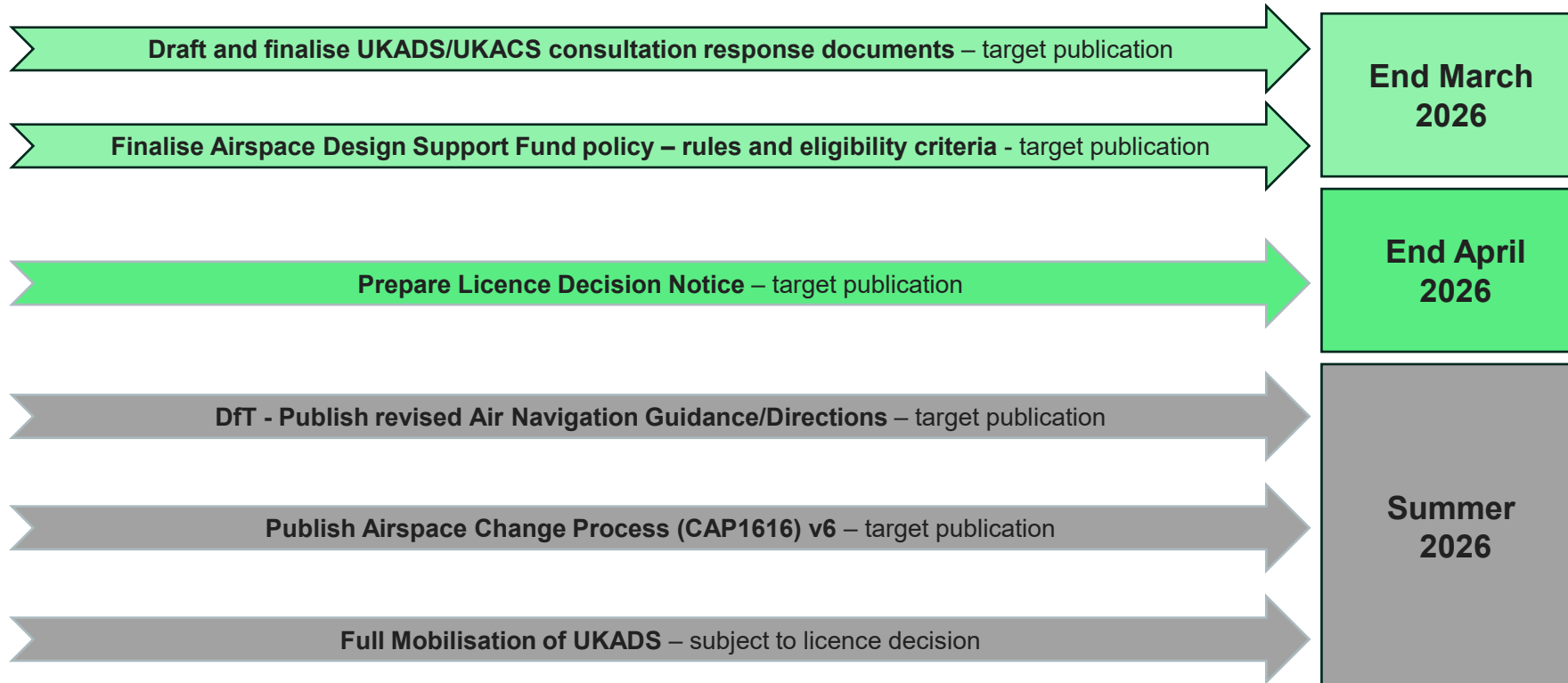

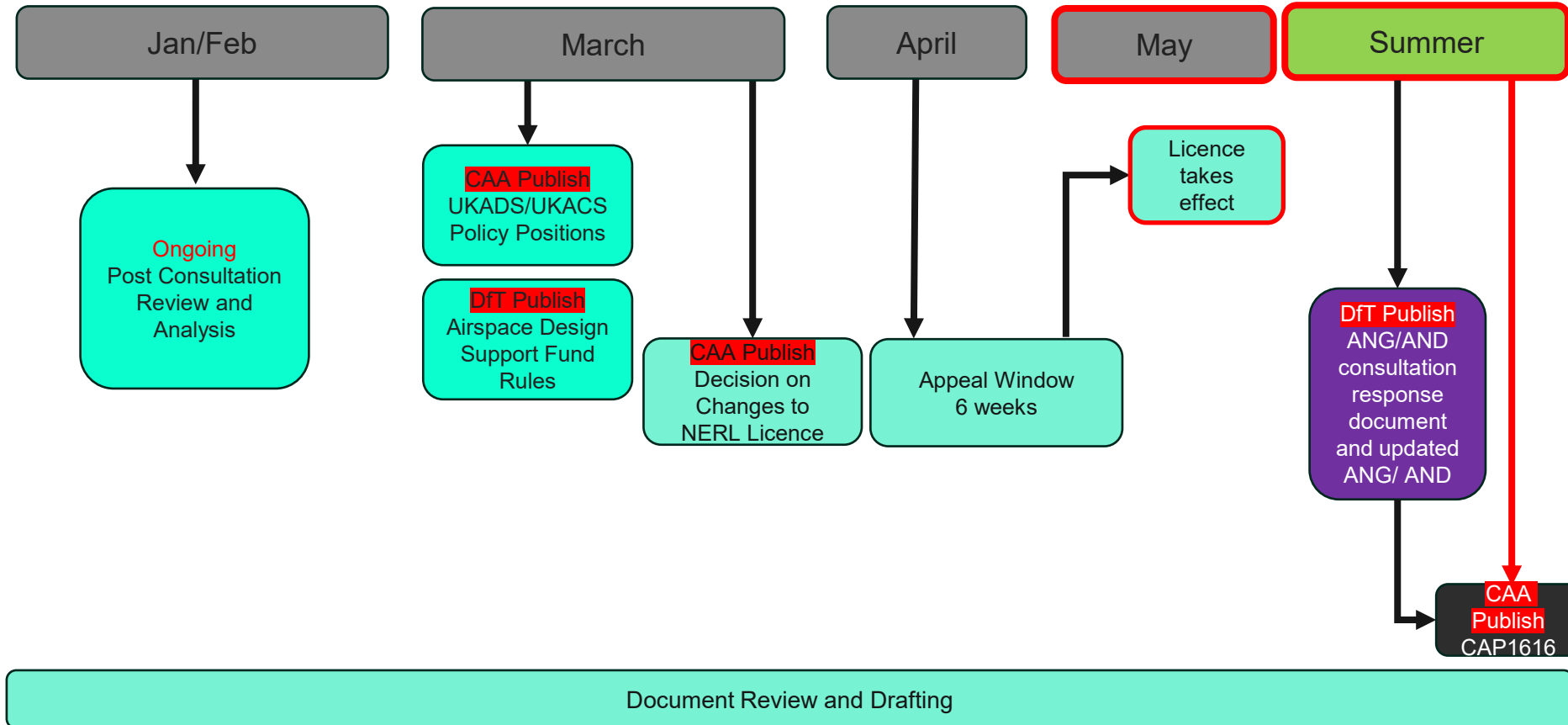
UKADS Progress to Date

- CAA/DfT concluded all UKADS related consultations in January 2026
- CAP3158 - Consultation on the draft guidance for the UK Airspace Design and Coordination Services
- CAP3159 - Consultation on the requirements for the UK Airspace Coordination Service and associated guidance
 - 69 and 47 responses received respectively - drawn from across all stakeholder groups
 - Constructive and comprehensive responses received
 - Analysis of feedback is ongoing and will be shared in the respective Consultation Response Documents
- CAP1616 - Consultation on proposed amendments to the Airspace Change Process
 - 230 responses received
 - Analysis of feedback is ongoing to inform drafting of CAP1616 v6
- Final Proposals on Changes to NERL licence – consultation concluded and analysis underway to inform the decision
- Air Navigation Guidance/Directions
 - c270 responses received
 - Analysis of feedback is ongoing to inform final decisions
- Finalise Airspace Design Support Fund policy – rules and eligibility criteria

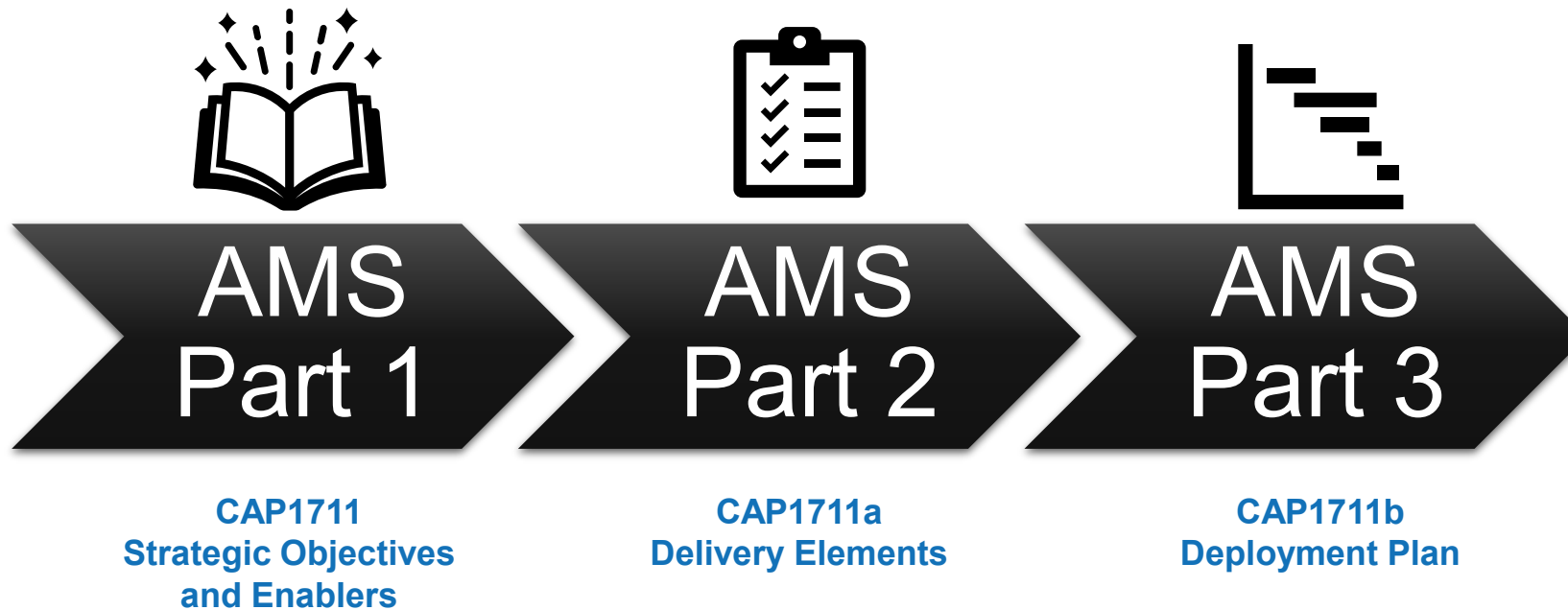


UK Airspace Design Service – Illustrative Target Dates



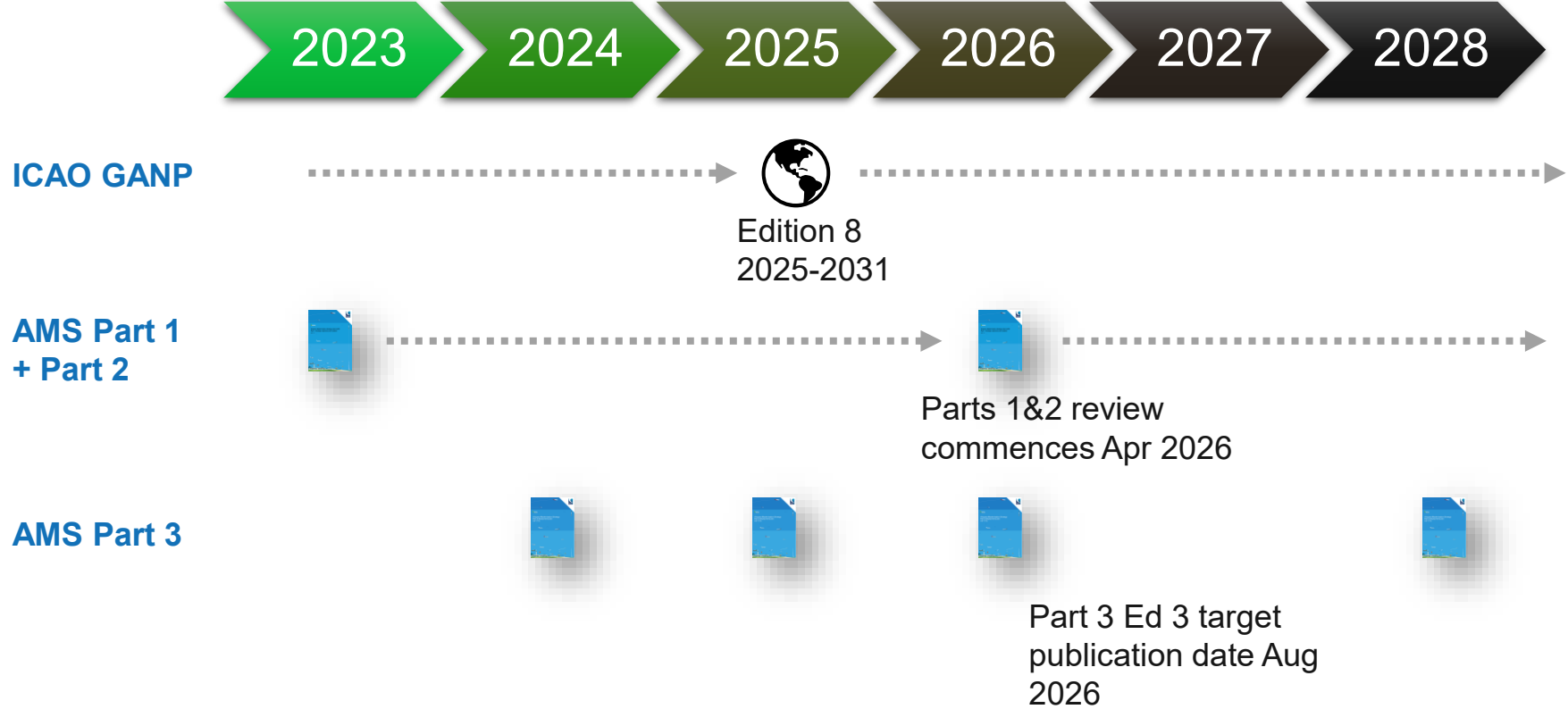
