### T4 Baggage Area

Go to Reclaim Belt 2 following the safe walking route internal to the Main Baggage Hall. Follow the signs to the event using the ..... dedicated footpath.

### Terminal Building

The closest point to access to the event from the terminal area is gate 405. From this point a safe walking route to the event will be signposted. A safe walking route is also available from Reclaim Belt 2 inside Baggage Reclaim Area.



The crossing from the equipment area by stand 405 to stand 461 will be monitored by a Road Traffic Marshal

## In The Event of Fire

Call APOC on **0208 759 1212** (from any mobile phone) or **222** (Internal), state "Fire" and give precise location.

Try to put out fire **ONLY** if safe and trained to do so.

Use the quickest fire exit route to the designated Assembly Point following the emergency exit signs. Evacuate in an orderly and timely manner and proceed to the nearest Assembly Point. Heathrow Airside Staff will assist the evacuation procedure by guiding all visitors to the assigned assembly point and will assist the Fire Service.
