
Airside standard

The above graph shows the amount of road traffic collisions that have taken place on the airfield in the past 12 months.

So far in 2023, there have been 119 reported road traffic collisions. 49 of these collisions took place on the airside road network. Please ensure you're vigilant when pulling out onto main roads and keeping a safe distance from the vehicles in front of you.

We appreciate how busy it is out on the road network, especially during the busy flight peaks, but please ensure you're taking care when manoeuvring around the network and always carry out your vehicle inspection before any journey.

Summer Driving

Summer marks the start of longer day and warmer weather. Here's some tips on how to stay safe while driving over the summer....



Keep a bottle of water in the vehicle, a 5% drop in hydration levels can cause a drop of up to 30% in concentration levels

Keep windscreens clean as dirt and marks can amplify sun glare

Have access to and wear a clean pair of sunglasses while driving

Stay alert. The number of movements is increasing, causing more traffic on airside roads

Drive extra carefully after rain, as it can turn dry surfaces into a skid area. Roads can be extra slippery when it rains after a long period of dry weather.




Positive interaction

We want to ensure that positive safety behaviour is captured and recognised on the ramp, which is why we ask our operational teams to give out positive interactions.

In the month of March, there were 230 positive interactions reported by the compliance team. There were 9 categories of positive interactions captured across the month, with good turnaround activity being the most frequent. Followed by wearing seatbelts and correct PPE worn.

Road Traffic Collision -March hotspots


We have collated road traffic collision data from March 2023, to highlight hotspot areas.

Here are the top 3 hotspots

T5 Ring Road B West: Please be wary of vehicles pulling out of interstand clearways. High traffic volumes when turnaround taking place.

T5 Southern Service Road: Please stick to speed limit.

T5 Windsor Road: Please be wary of vehicles pulling out of interstand clearways. High traffic volumes when turnaround taking place.
