

## 1. Introduction




This Operational Advice Notice has been written to give all airside road users notice that United Airlines have taken ownership of the hangar TBN (the old BMI hangar behind Stand 703).

To this end, driving onto or across Stand 703 and 704 is not permitted by any vehicles other than those operated by United Airlines, or those that have received permission from United Airlines.

For those vehicles wishing to access CP12 from the maintenance area, they are to follow the existing procedures and wait at the G4S holding point until instructed by the G4S guard to proceed to lane 2. The HAL security officer will liaise with the G4S guard ensuring that lane 2 is vacant. Drivers will ensure that it is safe to proceed by observing merging traffic from the landside lane.
