1. Introduction

Following the success of the One Stop Security trial that commenced in February 2025, there is now a dedicated pick up facility for passengers in Terminal 3. As a result of this, there is a change of purpose to part of the Terminal 3 remote coaching arrivals drop off at Gate 24.

The last door of the Terminal 3 Coaching Gate, door no. 102 as indicated in the drawing below, will no longer be used for coached arrival passengers. It is now designated solely for One Stop Security operations for departing passengers.

All other doors remain unchanged and should be used for coached arrival passengers.






































2. Additional Information
