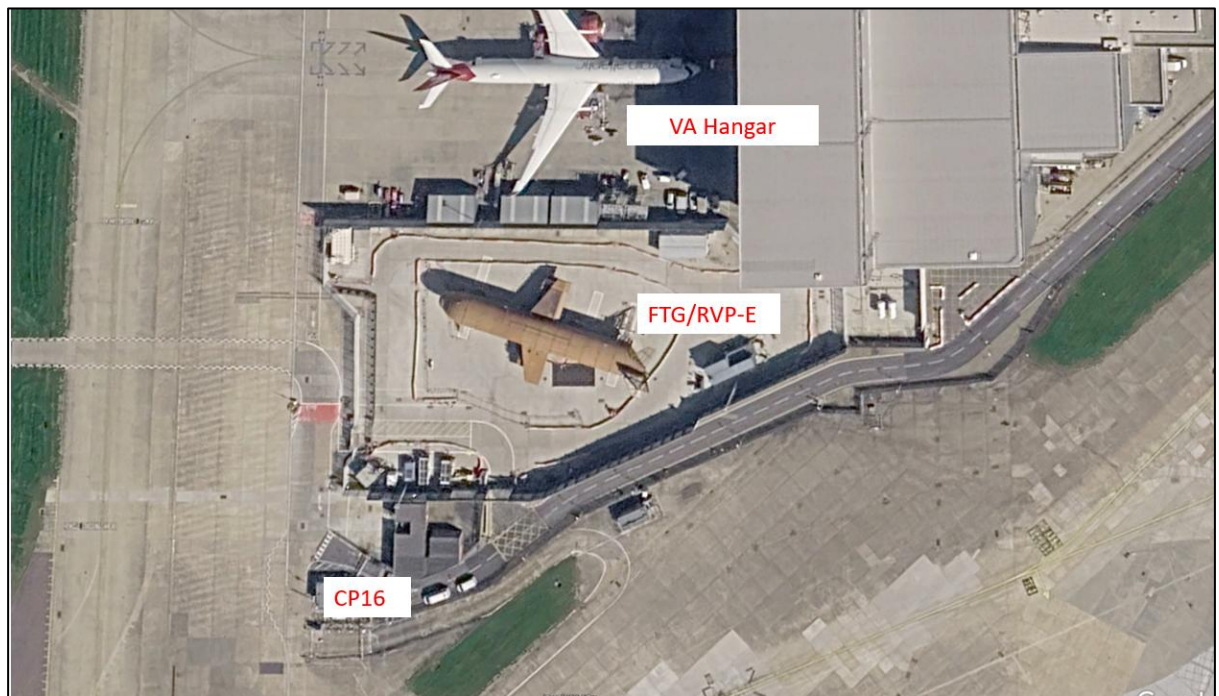
Return to Service of Fire Training Ground (FTG) / RVP-East

1. FTG / RVP-East Back in Service

- 1.1** This OAN advises the community that the Fire Training Ground (FTG) / RVP-E will be brought back into service and available for use from Monday **10th August 2026** from **17:00 (local)**.

2. Use of Fire Training Ground (FTG)

- 2.1** The project delivering the new fire training rig for Heathrow Airport Fire Service (AFRS) is now complete.
- 2.2** The community are advised that there will be increased activity in the area, including on the road in front of the FTG and on the adjacent taxiway. All personnel are asked to exercise caution when transiting through this area.

3. Security

- 3.1** Following any visit to this area, personnel must either remain within the Other Airside Area (OAA), vacate the airfield via an egress point, or present themselves for search.
