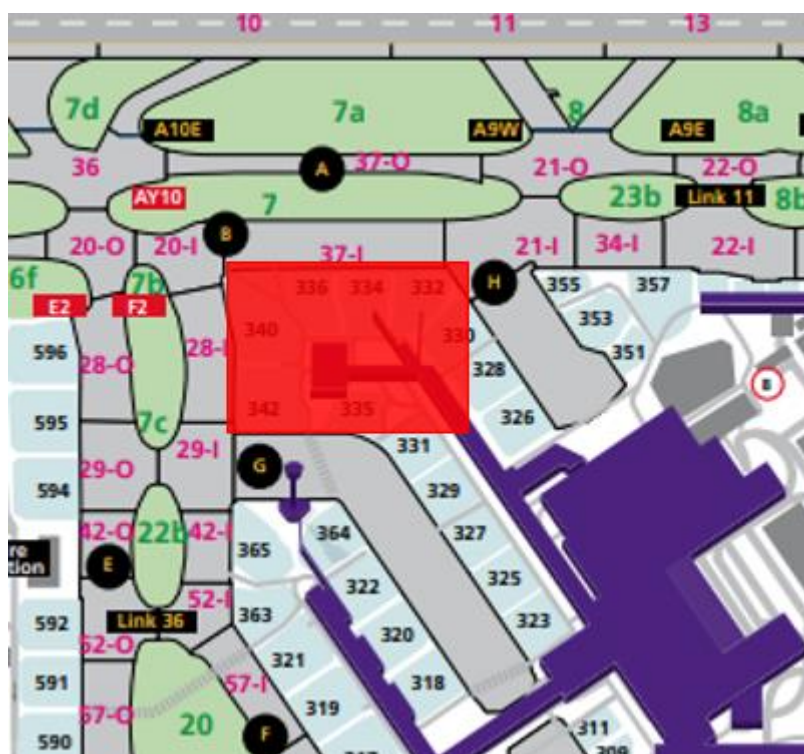
## Terminal 3 Pre Conditioned Air Trial

### 1. Introduction

Alternative Pre Conditioned Air (PCA) units have been installed as part of a trial on six aircraft stands in Terminal 3. The installation has been completed and the trial use of the 6 new units will commence on **Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2022**.

This trial is currently planned for 18 months and the use of the units is only permitted by Airlines or Ground Handlers who have signed a commercial agreement with the company undertaking the trial, Smart Airport Systems.

The mobile PCA units are installed on the following stands:

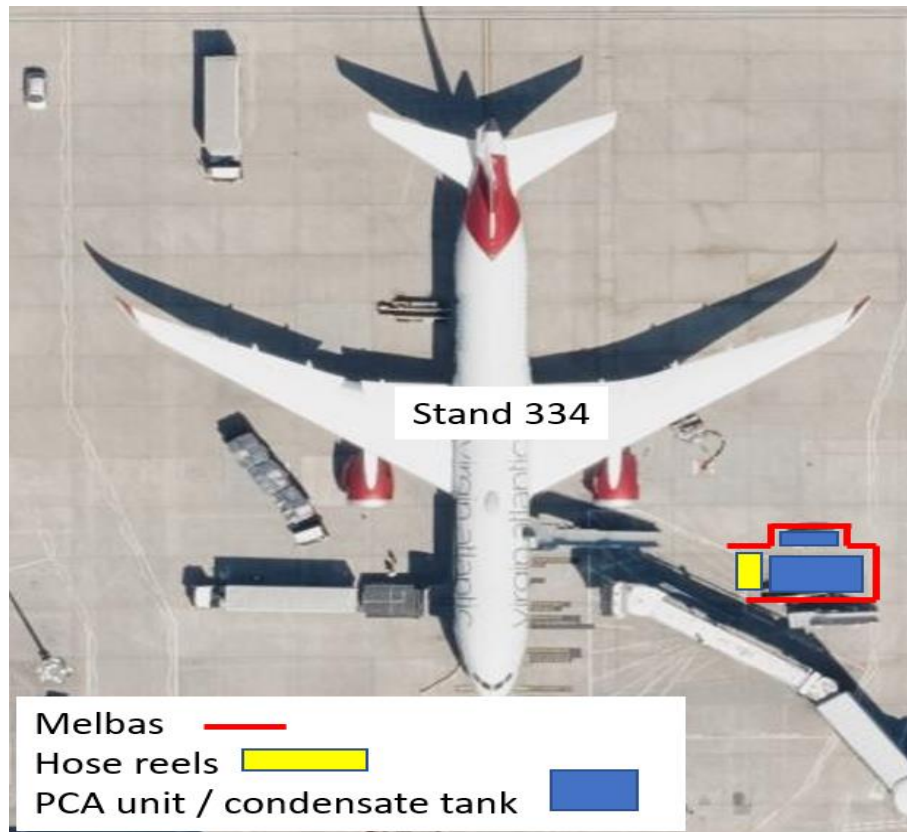
