




1. Introduction

This Operational Advice Notice has been written to give all airside users notice of changes that are now in place to walking routes around the Terminal 2 Baggage Recovery Facility (formerly Iridium Triangle).

As the area is largely closed off for construction, to safeguard pedestrians there are no walkways through the site. Those requiring access either North or South of the construction area can do so using the walkways in accordance with **Drawing A**, with part of this route leading through the terminal building. Alternatively, staff are encouraged to travel by vehicle through the area. A separate OAN will cover off road layout changes as the project progresses.






Drawing A – Construction Period Walking Routes
