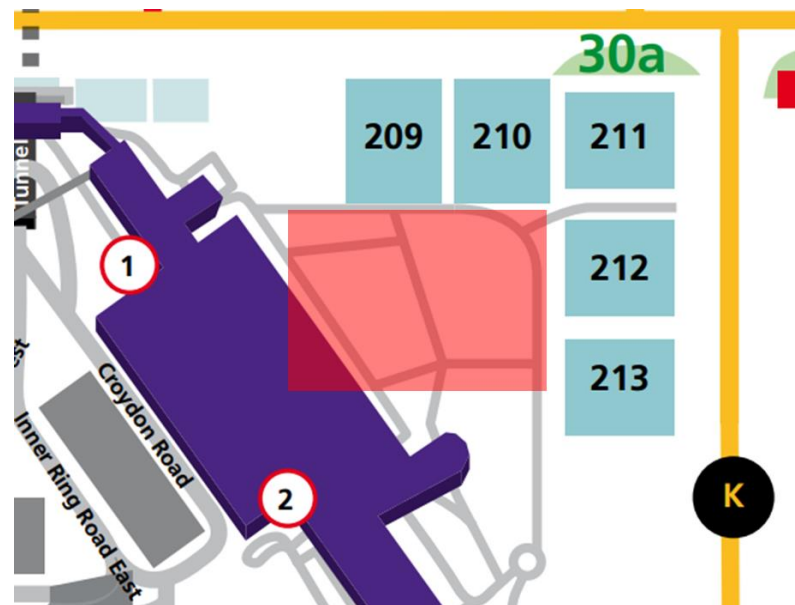

1. Introduction

This Operational Advice Notice has been written to give all airside users notice of road alterations that were made around the Terminal 2 Baggage Recovery Facility (formerly Iridium Triangle).

In order to allow Costain to progress, further construction areas are required along the roadway.

Drawing A on the following page (shows in **RED**) indicates the parts of road which will be closed, and illustrates the planned traffic routes available for road users. **These alterations were made on 28th May 2024 and will now remain in place until further notice, due to a delay in the start of Phase 2.**

ASWorks_OAN_322, T2 Baggage Recovery Facility – Road Alterations (Phase 2) (Version 1.0) has been temporarily suspended.
