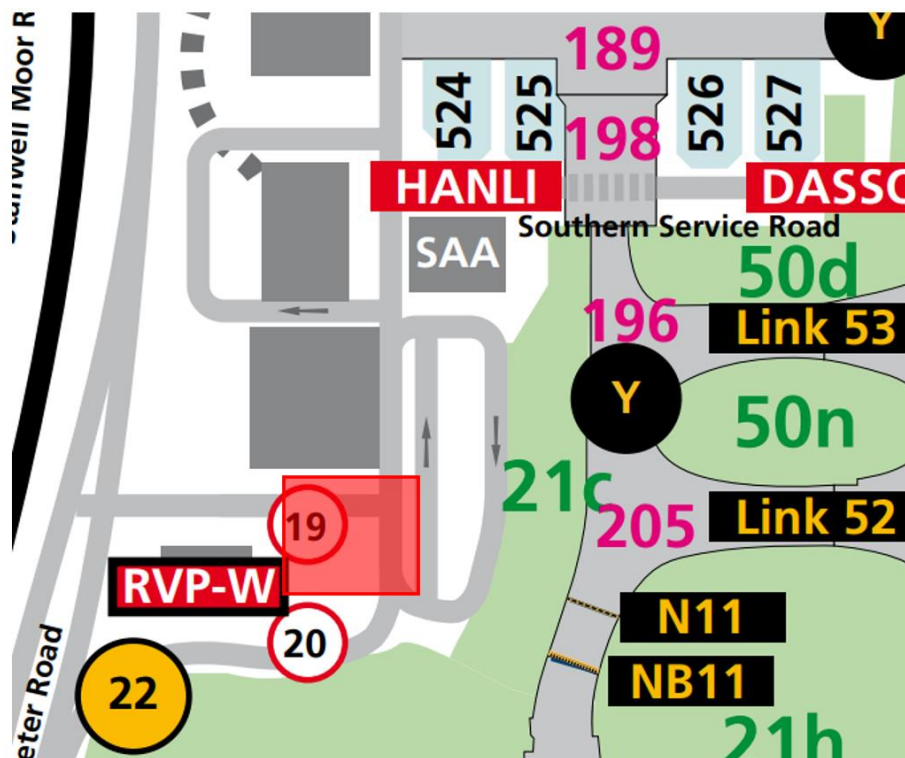
Terminal 5 - Temporary Smoking Area (Control Post 19)

1. Introduction

As part of the next phase of works of the Control Post 19 project, the contractors will be extending the site boundary to include the area south of the Control Post. As a result, the current smoking shelter located by Control Post will be closed.

This closure will take effect on **Wednesday 25th September 2024 from 0700hrs.**

While the current smoking shelter is closed, a temporary smoking shelter will be made available along with parking spaces. The new location is to the east of Control Post 20 and can be seen in **Drawing A** on the following page. The temporary smoking shelter will be available for use on **Wednesday 25th September 2024 from 0700hrs.**

All users MUST park in the allocated spaces if driving to the smoking shelter and use the safe walking route that has been provided if accessing by foot. Please pay particular attention to any speed restrictions and signage in situ.
