- 1.3 Red bars have been added to the side of the document to draw the reader's attention to where changes have been made.

- 3.1 The updated electronic versions of the maps will include:
 - Update of runway holding point marking Alpha 1.
 - 3.1.2 Reinstatement of Kilo northern side uncontrolled crossing (between Stands 211 and 231).
 - **3.1.3** Removal of Kilo southern side uncontrolled crossing (between Stands 216 and 237).
 - **3.1.4** Removal of old runway holding point markings Alpha 1, Alpha 2 and Alpha 3.
 - Removal of temporary closure signages.
 - **3.1.6** Change the colour of Fourth Avenue to reflect a 20 Mph speed limit.
 - 3.1.7 A line is drawn just after the uncontrolled crossing at CP16 to demark Blocks 808 and 44
