Airfield Map

- 1.1 The purpose of this OSI is to highlight key changes made to the Airfield & Road Maps.

 - Heathrow Ground Movement Map

The updated electronic versions published 9th July 2021 now include:

- Introduction of Code F taxiway centreline from Link 23 to AY1 and AY1 to A1
- Update to Alpha Taxiway (West) to rectify printing error
