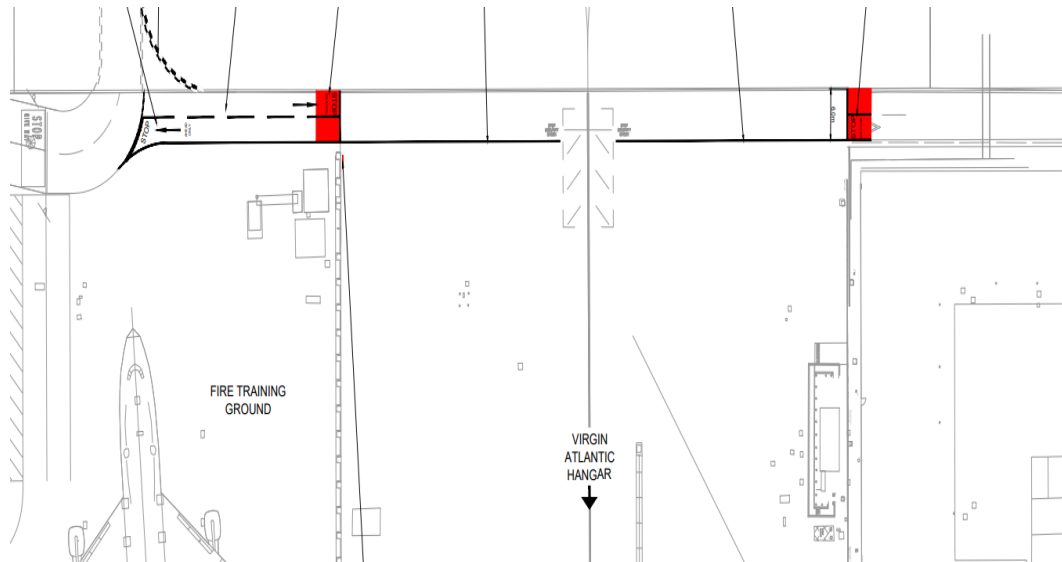


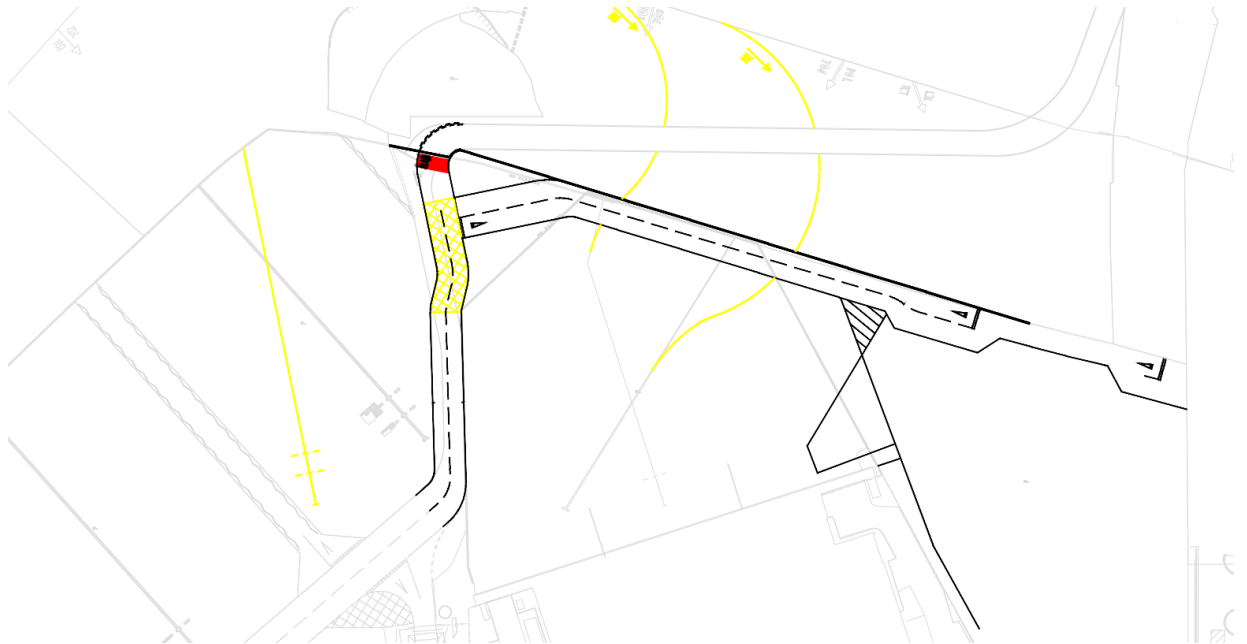
2. Virgin Atlantic Maintenance Facility

A roadway has been provided, crossing the rear of the Virgin Maintenance Facility. Road users must stop and give way to all aircraft entering or exiting the facility area.



3. United Airlines Maintenance Facility

A roadway has been provided, crossing the rear of the United Airlines Maintenance Facility. Road users must stop and give way to all aircraft entering or exiting the facility area. Road users must **NOT** wait or park in the hatched area.



4. Roadway Operation

There will be occasions when parts of the road may need to be closed, for example behind the United Airlines Maintenance Facility so that engineering works can be carried out on certain aircraft types safely. On these occasions, British Airways will be contacted by Airside Operations and the road users will need to seek alternative routes for the duration of the road closure.

All signage must be observed at all times.

The speed limit on the roadway is **20mph**.

All vehicles should remain on the dedicated road and not drive across any aircraft stand, unless servicing the aircraft on the stand.
