#### 1. Introduction

Early on the morning of 13<sup>th</sup> June, a Team Heathrow colleague was struck by a vehicle on the roadway near stand 453. The colleague was taken by emergency ambulance to hospital and remains in a critical condition, and we understand that the family are with them.

An investigation has been initiated to fully investigate the incident.

#### 2. Safety Considerations

- Remind colleagues of the hazards and risk associated with potential pedestrian and vehicle conflict on the airfield
- Continue to promote the Heathrow Safety Six to all airside colleagues
- Intervene if you observe any unsafe acts and report close calls to Airside Operations
