Heathrow Express	Mainline (fast) - Heathrow to London Paddington	<p>Service is operating every 15 minutes, as follows</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> From London Paddington at 10, 25, 40 and 55 minutes past each hour from 05:10 until 23:25. From Terminal 5 at 12, 27, 42 and 57 minutes past each hour from 05:12 until 23:57 on Mondays to Saturdays and from 05:27 until 23:57 on Sundays and Public Holidays. From Terminals 2 and 3 to London Paddington at 02, 17, 32 and 47 minutes past each hour from 05:17 until 23:47, then 00:03. <p>Please check times at www.nationalrail.co.uk</p>
Elizabeth line	Mainline - Heathrow to London Paddington	<p>Trains are operating as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Approximately every 15 mins between London Paddington and Terminals 2,3 Every 30 mins between London Paddington and Terminal 4 Every 30 mins between London Paddington and Terminal 5. <p>Please use this link for the full timetable - https://tfl.gov.uk/modes/elizabeth-line/elizabeth-line-timetables</p>
Piccadilly line	London Underground (Tube)	<p>Tube trains to Heathrow operate as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Every 5 minutes between central London and Heathrow Terminals 2, 3, but alternate journeys from central London operate via Terminal 4, adding approximately 10 mins to the journey time compared with Tubes terminating at Terminal 5 Every 10 mins between central London and Heathrow Terminal 4 Every 10 mins between central London and Heathrow Terminal 5 <p>There is currently no Night Tube in operation on the Piccadilly Line.</p>
Inter-Terminal Transfer	Terminals 2,3 to Terminal 4 and 5	<p>An Oyster Card or contactless bank card is required to activate the ticket gates on Heathrow Express, the Elizabeth line and the Piccadilly line. You won't be charged so long as you only travel between terminals. Alternatively, if you are using the Heathrow Express or Elizabeth line, you can obtain a free Inter-Terminal Transfer ticket from the dedicated machines.</p> <p>When using the Piccadilly line to Terminal 4, change trains at Hatton Cross. Please note, you will be charged if you exit the station at Hatton Cross.</p>

Always check online before travelling, as engineering work can affect timetables, particularly at weekends.
