<b>Heathrow Express</b>	Mainline (fast) - Heathrow to London Paddington	<p>Service is operating every 15 minutes, as follows</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>From London Paddington at 10, 25, 40 and 55 minutes past each hour from 05:10 until 23:25.</li> <li>From Terminal 5 at 12, 27, 42 and 57 minutes past each hour from 05:12 until 23:57 on Mondays to Saturdays and from 05:27 until 23:57 on Sundays and Public Holidays.</li> <li>From Terminals 2 and 3 to London Paddington at 02, 17, 32 and 47 minutes past each hour from 05:17 until 23:47, then 00:03.</li> </ul> <p>Please check times at <a href="http://www.nationalrail.co.uk">www.nationalrail.co.uk</a></p>
<b>TfL Rail</b>	Mainline - Heathrow to London Paddington	<p>A special timetable is in operation, as Terminal 4 is temporarily closed. Trains are operating approximately every 15 mins between London Paddington and Terminals 2, 3, and every 30 mins between London Paddington and Terminal 5. <b>Piccadilly Line</b>	London Underground (Tube)	<p>A special timetable is in operation as Terminal 4 is temporarily closed. All Tubes to Heathrow Terminal 5 also call at Terminals 2 and 3. Additional Tubes from central London operate to Hatton Cross. Approximate daytime frequencies on all days of the week are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Central London to Hatton Cross - every 5 minutes</li> <li>Central London to Heathrow Terminals 2, 3 and 5 - every 10 minutes</li> <li>Heathrow Terminal 5 to central London – every 10 minutes</li> <li>Heathrow Terminals 2 and 3 to central London – every 5 minutes</li> </ul> <p>There is currently no Night Tube in operation on the Piccadilly Line.</p>
<b>Inter-Terminal Transfer</b>	Terminals 2,3 to Terminal 4 and 5	<p>An Oyster Card or contactless bank card is required to activate the ticket gates on Heathrow Express, TfL Rail and the Piccadilly Line. You won't be charged so long as you only travel between terminals. Alternatively, if you are using the Heathrow Express or TfL Rail service, you can obtain a free Inter-Terminal Transfer ticket from the dedicated machines.</p> <p>The Inter-Terminal Transfer to/from Terminal 4 is currently suspended.</p>

Always check online before travelling, as engineering work can affect timetables, particularly at weekends.
