Provider	Services	Details
Arriva	724	Normal service. If paying by cash, please give the exact fare if possible.
Carlone	442	Approximately hourly, 7 days a week from very early to very late.
First Berkshire	4	Up to every 30 mins every day of the week between Heathrow and Slough, up to every 30 mins to Maidenhead on Mondays to Fridays, 60 mins at weekends.
First Berkshire	7	Up to every 30 minutes on Mondays to Fridays, and early morning Sat/Sun.
First Berkshire	8/8A	Up to every 30 minutes on Mondays to Saturdays. Hourly on Sundays.
First Berkshire	RA1	Up to every 35 minutes on Mondays to Fridays and hourly on Sat/Sun. Now with additional stops at Cemetery Junction and Bray Wick. Coaches have returned to setting-down right outside Terminals 2 and 3.
First Berkshire	RA2	Hourly service on all days. Now serving Woking instead of Wisley.
Flixbus	041, 042, 046 N02	Services to/from London Victoria, Bristol/South Wales, Leicester, Nottingham, South Yorkshire, West Yorkshire and Manchester.
Hallmark	555	Approximately hourly, 7 days a week from very early to very late
Hotel Hoppa	H2A/B/C/D H5A/B/C/D	H2A, H2B, H2D and H5B operating hourly. H2C, H5A, H5C and H5D are operating every 30 minutes until approximately 15:30, then hourly.
megabus	M3, M7, M10, M15	Services to/from London Victoria, Poole, Bristol/South Wales, West Midlands, Manchester, Newcastle-under-Lyme, Warrington, Liverpool, Huddersfield, Leeds, Middlesbrough, Sunderland and Newcastle.
National Express	025, 035, 202, 204, 210, 230, 240, 401/3/4/6, 423 444, 492, 501/2/4, 594/5, 707, 727, A40	Services to/from London Victoria and London Paddington, Worthing/Brighton, Portsmouth, Poole, Bath, Gloucester, Somerset and Devon, Bristol/South Wales, Norfolk, West Midlands via Northampton, Nottingham via Leicester, Liverpool via Chester, West Yorkshire, Edinburgh and Glasgow.
Oxford Bus Company	The Airline (X70 and X80)	Operating every 30 minutes during the day, and every 2 hours during the night. All coaches serve High Wycombe Park & Ride, where free car parking for 96 hours is provided.
Reading Buses	703	Approximately hourly, 7 days a week. New very early morning and late evening journeys between Slough and Terminal 5 now operating.
TfL	Various	Normal service operating on all routes. Route A10 is now operating every 20 minutes during the daytime on Mon-Sat and every 30 minutes in the evenings and on Sundays. Route N9 is now operating every 30 minutes every night of the week. Free travel is no longer available on any TfL bus service at Heathrow.
