He requested support in improving passenger forecasts to help plan resourcing. The group supported the approach but expressed concerns over long delays for non-EEA passengers and the number of e-gates which were closed or out of service. - Security strategy was discussed. - The group agreed that there needed to be improvements in service for the most vulnerable passengers.
