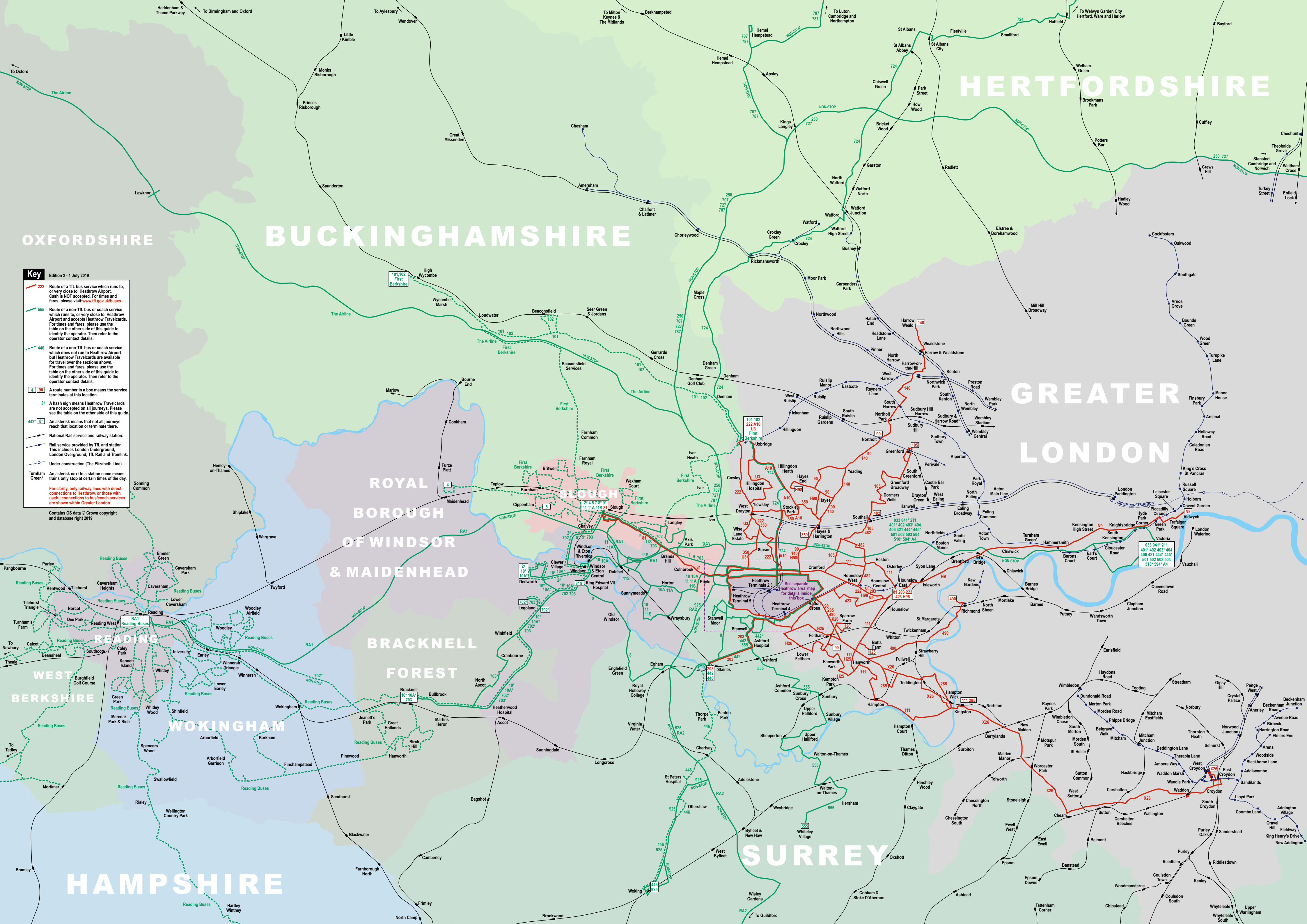

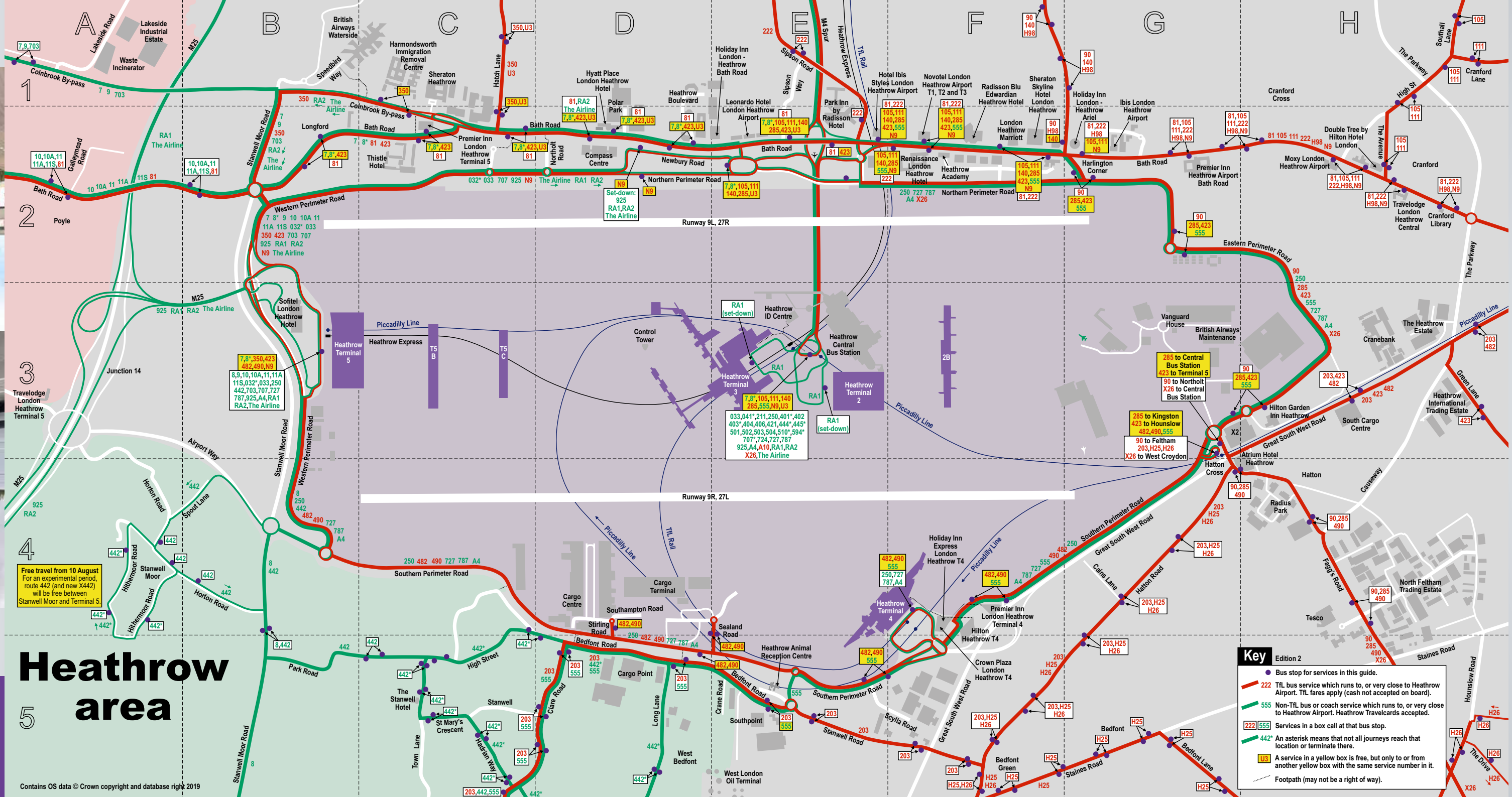

## CHANGES SINCE LAST TIME

- Heathrow Travelcard validity on buses operated by First Berkshire and Reading Buses has been expanded
- £25/£250 Heathrow Travelcards are no longer valid for travel between Windsor (Clewley, Prince Albert) and Bracknell on routes 10, 10A, 702 and 703
- Maps have been updated to include the latest route changes, including the new RA2 (Guildford – Terminal 5 – Compass Centre – Central Bus Station) and The Airline now picking up at the Compass Centre towards Oxford
- The Heathrow Free Travel Zone will include bus route 442 (and new route X442) between Stanwell Moor and Heathrow Terminal 5 from 10 August 2019.

## FREE TRAVEL ZONE

Some bus services are free to use within the Heathrow Free Travel Zone. These services are shown on the Heathrow area map within yellow boxes at bus stops. Free travel is only available between two bus stops with the same service number in a yellow box.

From 10 August 2019 for an experimental period, the Free Travel Zone is extended to include route 442 (and new X442) for journeys between Stanwell Moor and Heathrow Terminal 5.

TfL Rail trains are free between Terminals 2,3 and Terminal 4. Heathrow Express trains are free between Terminals 2,3 and Terminal 5. A free Inter-Terminal Transfer ticket must be obtained from machines at the station, or you can use an Oyster Card or a contactless credit card.

The Piccadilly Line is also free between all terminals, but only by using an Oyster Card (with sufficient credit) or contactless bank card. Please note, the use of Hatton Cross Station is for changing trains; you will be charged for your journey if you enter or exit at Hatton Cross.
